



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

AND NOW, this 6th day of April, 2020, in an effort to curb the spread of COVID-19 at the Clarion County Jail, which is the location of the county's central booking and fingerprinting facilities, all fingerprint orders previously issued are hereby suspended until May 9, 2020. Fingerprint orders will not be processed at the Clarion County Jail on Saturdays as usual until May 9, 2020. Further, any new fingerprint orders issued shall direct individuals to report for fingerprinting on a date after May 9, 2020. This order shall not prohibit fingerprinting of individuals that are incarcerated. Fingerprinting shall continue as part of the commitment process.
