**SECOND AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

AND NOW, this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2020, pursuant to the Supreme Court's Orders dated March 16, 2020, and April 1, 2020, extending the temporary, general closure of Pennsylvania Courts, this Court's Administrative Orders dated March 18, 2020 and April 6, 2020 are Amended to extend the Declaration of Judicial Emergency through May 31, 2020.

The operation of Rule of Criminal Procedure 600, relating to speedy trials, shall remain suspended in the 49<sup>th</sup> Judicial District during the period of the local judicial emergency.

Jury selection scheduled for June 1, 2020 and June 2, 2020 is cancelled.


