5. Are you considered to be an individual in a vulnerable Covid-19 population due to age or health condition? If so, and if you are willing, please describe.
6. Do you have any other concerns related to Covid-19 that might impact your ability to serve on the jury? If so, and if you are willing, please explain.
7. Within the last 14 days, have you traveled to any State that the Governor has put on the recommended quarantine list?
