**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**


**AND NOW THIS** 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020,

**WHEREAS**, the Orphans' Court Clerk is scheduled to present accounts for confirmation at 9:30 a.m., Thursday, April 2, 2020 in the assigned courtroom of the Franklin County Courthouse before the undersigned judge;

**AND WHEREAS**, there exists a Judicial Emergency, under the March 18, 2020 Pennsylvania Supreme Court order;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the only party to appear for confirmation of accounts is the Orphans' Court Clerk or his designee and a Court Reporter. No other party or attorney shall be present. In the event any party appears at the courthouse seeking to come forward before the court to lodge an objection, it is hereby ordered that the court will hold all accounts for a period of 10 days to permit any parties who physically appeared at the court to protest and were denied access to file a written objection. Absent evidence that a party appeared at the court and was turned away by security staff and no written objections were filed prior to the presentation of the account, the court will assume that the accounting should be approved in accordance with existing rules.


