

Visitation schedules :

AND NOW, this *19th* day of March, 2020 in light of the serious public health concerns regarding the potential for transmission of contagious disease and illness, specifically relating to the Coronavirus (COVID-19), and in the interest of the protection of county employees, the general public, and the children currently in custody of the county agency, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED** that all visitations court ordered as part of a dependency proceeding shall “virtual visitation” and shall be conducted via telecommunicating. Telecommunicating shall include phone calls, video conference technology, Facetime, Skype or any other form of virtual visitation.

Susquehanna Services for Children and Youth shall take all reasonable steps to ensure virtual visitations can occur including ensuring that interested parties have access to either a smart phone, webcam or other device necessary to effectuate the visit.

This Order shall remain in effect until such time as the public health agencies deem the threat posed by COVID-19 has passed and the County resumes normal business practices.
