

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Effective immediately and until modified by further order of court, the current last day to plea procedure in McKean County is modified as follows: the parties (Defendant, Commonwealth, Defense Counsel) shall not appear in court for the "Last Day to Plea." Instead, the parties shall, on or before the listed last day to plea, conference in a manner that the parties choose (via telephone, electronically, in person) and send written notification to the court as to whether: 1) the parties have reached a plea agreement; 2) the case should be listed for trial; or, 3) a continuance is requested. If the parties indicate that they have reached a plea agreement they may notify court administration that the case is for the entry of a plea. If a party sends such notification to the court they shall assure that they provide a copy of that written notification to the opposing party. If notification is provided to court administration that a plea agreement has been reached, the court will issue an order setting a date for sentence and directing the Adult Probation Department to prepare pre-sentence material. The entry of the plea and sentence will be scheduled to be held at the same time. If the court does not receive written notification for last day to plea proceedings scheduled between March 19, 2020, and April 14, 2020, the court will continue last day to plea for those cases.
