

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER-Extension

AND NOW, to wit, this 29 day of May, 2020, pursuant to the Supreme Court's Orders dated March 16, 2020, April 1, 2020, April 28, 2020, and May 27, 2020 (Nos. 531 and 532 Judicial Administration Docket), the judicial emergency declared in the 22nd Judicial District of Pennsylvania on March is hereby extended until further Order of Court. The Court further orders:

1. The operation of Rule of Criminal Procedure 600, relating to speedy trials, shall remain suspended in the 22nd Judicial District until further Order of Court.
2. Jury trials shall remain cancelled until the September 2020 trial term.
3. Motions Court shall remain cancelled throughout the month of June 2020.
4. The Court is transitioning to a blend of live and remote proceedings beginning on June 1, 2020. The election of live versus remote will remain at the discretion of the Court, subject to petition by any party to an action.
