**DECLARATION**

AND NOW, this 7<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2021, per the Supreme Court's Order dated May 27, 2020 authorizing President Judges to declare judicial emergencies in their judicial districts, I declare that the judicial emergency in the 19th Judicial District is extended through September 30, 2021. During the emergency the following shall apply:

- (1) The Court and other agencies located in judicial facilities shall limit in-person access and proceedings in order to safeguard the health and safety of court personnel, court users, and members of the public;
- (2) All persons in all judicial facilities of this court shall at all times and in all locations wear face coverings as defined by Pennsylvania's Secretary of Health; and
- (4) Any statewide rules that restrict, directly or indirectly, the use of advanced communication technologies are suspended.
