Yellow Books, Blue Books, in-person ballots, mail-in ballots, absentee ballots, provisional  
ballots, unused ballots, ballot stubs, computer-generated results tapes, ballot boxes, voting  
machines, ballot reconciliation forms, return sheets, electronic media containing election  
precinct election materials, and any and all other materials necessary to complete an  
analysis of the votes of each precinct within the 9<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District.
