for Pennsylvania's 9<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District and, in support thereof, aver as follows

1 The Petitioners are as follows

2 A petition raising an election contest for a senatorial contest must be made and filed within twenty days after the date of the election, must contain the names of 20 petitioners, and must be verified by the affidavits of at least five of the petitioners 25 P S §§ 3456-58

3 A petition contesting the results of an election must set out a prima facie case that the election results complained of are illegal and that the results of the election are not correct 25 P S § 3458

4 Contested elections of a Senator in the General Assembly “shall be tried and determined by the court of common pleas of the county where the person returned as such shall reside” 25 P S § 3401

5 On November 3, 2020, a General Election was held, *inter alia*, for Pennsylvania’s 9<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District (the “Election”), which encompasses portions of both Chester and Delaware Counties

6 The candidates for the 9<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District are John I Kane ("Kane") and Thomas H Killion ("Killion")

7 Based on the unofficial results posted on the Pennsylvania Department of State's website, Kane is the purported winner of the Election

8 Kane resides at 1109 Radley Drive, West Chester, Chester County, Pennsylvania 19382

9 Because the purported winner of the Election resides in Chester County, this Court has jurisdiction over this election contest

10 This Petition timely because it was filed within 20 days of the date of the Election

11 Attached hereto are the affidavits of 5 of the Petitioners stating that they believe the facts herein are true, that according to the best of their knowledge and belief that the election was illegal and the return thereof not correct, and that this petition is made in good faith True and correct copies of the Affidavits are attached hereto as Exhibit "A"

12 In Delaware County, two independent boards are involved in the administration of elections the Delaware County Board of Elections and the Delaware County Voter Registration Commission.

13 Administratively, the Board of Elections supervises the administrative arm, the Bureau of Elections, as well as the Voting Machine Warehouse Operations, while the Voter Registration Commission conducts its operations through the Voter Registration Department These 3 departments are involved in various capacities in the official computation of votes and ballots cast in the November 3, 2020 election Petitioners are



without knowledge as to other individuals involved in the computation and also without knowledge as to each department's specific responsibilities and involvement

14 The Delaware County Board of Elections and the Delaware County Voter Registration Commission are nominal respondents in this matter

15 The integrity of an election can be measured by comparing the number of ballots that should have been cast in an election based upon the number of signatures in a poll book (in Delaware County, the "Blue Book") and the number of names in a chronological numbered list of actual voters (in Delaware County, the "Yellow Book") against the number of ballots actually placed into the ballot box

16 In a lawful election, the number of signatures in the Blue Book, names in the Yellow Book, and ballots contained within the ballot box should be equal

17 Based upon information and belief, at many precincts throughout Delaware County, the number of ballots actually cast at the Election by registered electors differs greatly from the number of ballots that should have been cast based upon the number of names in the Yellow Book

18 By way of example, but not of limitation, the following precincts had large-scale differences between the number of ballots that should have been in the ballot box and the number of ballots actually contained therein

19 Strikingly, the Chester 1-5 precinct reported only 51 names within the Yellow Book, yet counted 287 ballots in the ballot box

20 These issues occurred throughout the 9<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District and, in fact, throughout all of Delaware County, without explanation See the Precinct Yellow Book/Public Count Master Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit "B"

21 Inquiries into the reason for these discrepancies were made to the Delaware County Bureau of Elections and no response has been forthcoming

22 To date, Petitioners have not been permitted to review the poll books containing signatures of electors (the Blue Books) to determine the number of ballots that should have been placed in each precinct's ballot box

23 Without such access, the election results within Delaware County, on their face, call into question the legality of the election and are not correct, the full magnitude and extent of which are not known

24 Accordingly, Petitioners have probable cause to bring this action and have presented a prima facie case that an election contest is warranted

25 As required by 25 P S § 3459, Petitioners are prepared to file a bond, in an amount set by the Court, within 5 days of the filing of this Petition, should it be determined that the petitioners shall be adjudged liable to pay said costs

26 Petitioners here are concerned electors, and therefore the bond should be nominal

27 Petitioners respectfully request this Court to issue an Order staying the final certification of the 9<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District within Delaware County under the power granted to this Court by 25 P S §§ 3404 and 3465, and also to require the Delaware County Board

of Elections and Voter Registration Commission to make available, at a mutually agreeable date and time but not more than 10 days after the date of the Order, all election materials for the November 3, 2020 General Election, including the voter rolls, Yellow Books, Blue Books, in-person ballots, mail-in ballots, absentee ballots, provisional ballots, unused ballots, ballot stubs, computer-generated results tapes, ballot boxes, voting machines, ballot reconciliation forms, return sheets, electronic media containing election precinct election materials, and any and all other materials necessary to complete an analysis of the votes of each precinct within the 9<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District

28      Petitioners respectfully request that a hearing in this matter shall be scheduled after Petitioners or their counsel are afforded an opportunity to review the election materials listed above


