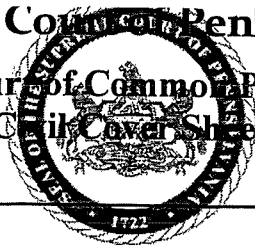

AND NOW on this _____ day of _____, 2020, upon consideration of the verified Petition Requesting a Recount/Recanvass of the above captioned nine precincts, and any response thereto, and finding that Petitioners' having posted the requisite sum of \$450.00 with the Office of Judicial Support, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that Petitioners' Petition is hereby granted and the Delaware County Board of Elections shall:

- 1) Make visible the registering counters, i.e., "v sticks" of the voting machine(s)/scanner(s) used to calculate the votes/ballots for the respective precincts, both walk-in and mail-in;
- 2) Open the ballot box(es) to cause the entire vote to be correctly counted by persons to be designated by the Court. The ballot box(es) shall include all election day walk-in ballots together with all mail-in and absentee ballots and provisional ballots received by the County of Delaware for such district(s) including all machine/scanner tabulations/receipts, i.e., "v sticks" for all ballots, together with official sign-in poll "blue" books, "yellow" minority poll books, and all provisional over-seas, and military ballots; and

- 3) The Board of Elections shall not certify the election returns for the 165th State Legislative District until further Order of this Court.

**PETITION PURSUANT TO 25 P.S. § 3261 AND 25 P.S. § 3262 OF THE
PENNSYLVANIA ELECTION CODE REQUESTING A RECOUNT/RECANVASS
OF THE UNCERTIFIED ELECTION RETURN RESULTS FROM THE
GENERAL ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 3, 2020 OF THE BELOW IDENTIFIED
ELECTION DISTRICTS**

The Twenty seven Petitioners identified herein, by and through their attorney, Hugh A. Donaghue, Esquire of Donaghue & Labrum, LLP, respectfully request a statutory recount of their respective precincts and in support of their request for a statutory recount, aver as follows:

1. On Tuesday, November 3, 2020, a general election, which included federal offices, was held throughout Pennsylvania, including Delaware County and for only the second time in Pennsylvania history, voters were permitted to cast ballots by mail, without an explanation or reason for using this vote by mail method.

2. The following nine Election Districts, also referred to herein as precincts in Delaware County, all located in the 165th State Legislative District, participated in the election on November 3, 2020:

- Radnor Township 3rd Ward 1st Precinct
- Radnor Township 4th Ward 1st Precinct
- Radnor Township 4th Ward 2nd Precinct
- Radnor Township 6th Ward 2nd Precinct
- Springfield Township 2nd Ward 3rd Precinct

- Springfield Township 3rd Ward 1st Precinct
- Springfield Township 4th Ward 3rd Precinct
- Springfield Township 5th Ward 3rd Precinct
- Morton Borough (the entire Borough is one precinct)

3. The Petitioners herein who signed the attached verified Petitions (attached hereto and collectively marked as Exhibit “A-1” through “A-13”) are registered and qualified electors in the identified precincts, who voted in the November 3, 2020 general election (“Petitioners”). There are three Petitioners from each of the above listed nine precincts.

4. Petitioners are requesting a statutory recount and/or recanvass of all the votes cast in these nine precincts including but not limited to votes cast by the use of absentee or mail-in ballots, general ballots, alternative or provisional ballots, those cast on ballots (including write-ins) at the identified precincts which ballots were (or should have been) scanned into the voting machines located at the identified precincts and provisional ballots cast at each of the identified precincts.

5. Petitioners’ statutory rights to a recount and/or recanvass are clear under the law as provided in 25 P.S. § 3261, titled Opening ballot boxes upon petition of electors alleging fraud or error; deposit or bond. A true and copy of 25 P.S. § 3261 is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked Exhibit “B” for the convenience of the Court.

6. Petitioners’ statutory rights to a recount and/or recanvass are also clear under the law as provided in 25 P.S. § 3262 titled, Recanvassing voting machines upon petition of electors alleging fraud or error. A true and copy 25 P.S. § 3262 is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked Exhibit “C” for the convenience of the Court.

7. The qualified electors of the identified Township, and Borough listed by Ward and Precinct (“Election District”) have executed and duly verified affidavits/verifications, true and correct copies of which are attached to this Petition and marked collectively as

Exhibits “A-1” through “A-13”, alleging that upon information which they consider reliable, they believe that error, although not manifest on the general return of votes made therefrom, was: (1) committed in the computation of the votes cast in every lawful manner and for all offices or for any particular office or offices in such Election Districts, or in the marking of the ballots, or in the scanning of the ballots or otherwise in connection with the tabulation of such ballots and/or (2) was committed in the canvassing of the votes cast on the voting machine or machines used in the Election District or filed by ballot box or mail. The originals of the affidavits/verifications collectively marked as Exhibits “A-1” through “A-13” will be handed up at the time of the Court proceeding on this matter, if any.

8. Your Petitioners have attempted to reconcile the reported votes cast in the election in their respective precincts based on publicly available information, but have been unable to do so, for reasons set forth hereinafter.

9. By way of illustration but not limitation as it is but one of hundreds of discrepancies discoverable in the official tabulation of votes, the Return Board’s records for the 6th Ward 2nd Precinct of Radnor note that the yellow book was **lost**, while the Blue Poll Book is noted as reflecting 794 voters who appeared and voted in person in the 2nd Precinct on election day. While the November 18, 2020, report for the County Board of Elections lists a mail in vote total for the 6th Ward 2nd Precinct of 786 votes, the County Board of Elections’ website notes that only 591 ballots were returned from the 6th Ward, 2nd Precinct, creating a disparity of 195 mail-in votes, as well as a disparity of at least three voters in the numbers of walk-in voters reflected on the blue and yellow poll books. (See Precinct Yellow/Public Blue Book Master Sheet attached hereto and marked as Exhibit “D”).)

10. Despite this, the Ballot reconciliation report (attached hereto as Exhibit “E”) from the Bipartisan Return Board reflects that the ballots were reconciled in the 6th Ward, 2nd Precinct and 4th Ward, 2nd Precinct of Radnor.

11. Again, by way of illustration but not limitation, in the 4th Ward, 2nd Precinct of Radnor, the yellow Book reflects 602 walk in voters on Election day while the blue Poll Book reflects 613 walk in voters creating a discrepancy of 11 voters. The County Election Board website report of November 18, 2020, reports 889 mail in votes in the precinct, and 627 live votes. The County Board of Elections absentee/mail in vote website, however, notes that only 729 mail in ballots were returned for the 4th Ward 2nd Precinct of Radnor, creating a discrepancy of 160 votes in the mail in votes, and a discrepancy of between 14 and 29 walk in votes.

12. The Board’s ballot reconciliation report, Exhibit “E”, notes that the ballots were not able to be reconciled in the 6th Ward, 1st Precinct of Radnor where the yellow book reflected 733 voters, the poll book reflected 719 voters, the County Board of Elections recorded 714 walk in votes and 773 mail in ballots, where only 612 mail in ballots are listed by the County as returned from the 6th Ward, 1st Precinct.

13. In the 3rd Ward, 1st Precinct of Radnor, the yellow book reflected 391 voters, the blue poll book reflects 393 voters (see Exhibit D) and yet the report of the Bureau of Elections reflects 394 walk in votes. Additionally, the November 18, 2020, Board of Elections report on its website notes that 431 mail in votes were counted in the precinct but the County website reflects that only 315 mail in ballots were returned in the 3rd Ward, 1st Precinct of Radnor.

14. In the 4th Ward, 1st Precinct of Radnor, the yellow book reflected 630 voters, the blue poll book reflected 652 voters and the Delaware County Board of Elections November 18, 2020 report notes 639 walk in votes, creating a discrepancy of 13 voters. The November 18,

2020, report notes 699 mail in ballot votes, despite the County reporting that only 540 mail in ballots were returned from the 4th Ward, 1st Precinct of Radnor.

15. The discrepancy between the number of ballots marked as returned to the County from all of the precincts in Radnor (7,406) and the number of mail-in votes tabulated by the County Board of Elections for all of Radnor (9,452) represents a discrepancy of 2,046 votes, or 21.6% of the mail-in vote counted in Radnor.

16. In the 4th Ward, 3rd Precinct of Springfield, the yellow book reflects 490 voters, while the blue poll book reflects 503 voters and the County Board of Elections reports 501 walk in votes and 266 mail in votes at the 4th Ward 3rd Precinct, despite the County posting that only 219 mail in ballots were returned from this precinct.

17. Also in the 4th Ward, 3rd Precinct, registered voters Denise L. Fulton and J. Lee Fulton of 90 S. Rolling Road, Springfield, PA 19064, deposited their mail in ballots in the Springfield Library drop box on or about October 31, 2020. The County website, however, notes their ballots as not having been returned (see page 2675 of the Delco Absentee/Mail in Ballot listing for the 4th Ward, 3rd Precinct of Springfield attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "F"), and the PAVOTES website as of November 18, 2020, listed their ballots as "pending", causing the Fultons to believe that their votes were not counted in the election despite their compliance with all prerequisites.

18. Springfield Township's 2nd Ward 3rd Precinct reported 549 voters in its yellow book, 550 voters in the blue poll book, while the Board of Elections reported 548 live votes in the precinct and 231 mail votes, despite the County Board of Elections reporting only 192 ballots being reported as returned from the precinct.

19. Springfield Township's 3rd Ward 1st Precinct reported 536 voters in its yellow book, 544 votes in the blue poll book, while the Board of Elections reported 532 live votes in the

precinct and 283 mail votes, despite the County Board of Elections reporting only 237 ballots being reported as returned from the precinct.

20. Springfield Township's 5th Ward 3rd Precinct reported 460 voters in its yellow book and 464 voters in the blue poll book, while the Board of Elections reported only 459 live votes in the precinct and 237 mail votes, despite the County Board of Elections reporting only 183 ballots being reported as returned from the precinct.

21. The 2nd Ward 3rd Precinct of Springfield report of mail in ballots lists Mary M. Zissimos, who is a resident of and voter lawfully registered at 408 Drew Avenue, Swarthmore PA. This registered voter is included in the list of 192 ballots returned from the 3rd precinct of the 2nd ward of Springfield. Presumably Ms. Zissimos' ballot was included in the Board of Elections Precinct results for Ward 2, Precinct 3 of Springfield which reported 548 live votes, 231 mail in votes where only 192 ballots were noted as returned. This voter's residence, and registered address is however located in the Swarthmore Borough, Western District, Precinct, and should have been so tabulated in the results for that precinct.

22. In Morton Borough the yellow book reflected 865 voters, the blue book reported 890 voters, but the Bureau of Elections reported 859 only walk-in votes. The Bureau also reported 743 mail in ballots, despite the County website reflecting only 613 ballots returned.

23. The Delaware County Return Board in the report attached hereto and marked Exhibit "E" noted that 89 precincts could not have their ballots reconciled or failed to report their returns to the Board to permit reconciliation.

24. As noted in Exhibit "E", the precinct summary created by the Return Board covering the 428 precincts in Delaware County, the Board was unable to reconcile the ballots in 78 precincts, or in an additional 17 precincts who could not be reached, resulting in a total of 95 precincts where the ballots could not be reconciled.

25. An explanation of the statutory Recount/Recanvass rights of all Pennsylvania voters is set forth in a thoughtful law review article by Clifford B. Levine & David J. Montgomery, *Post-Election Litigation in Pennsylvania*, 41 Duq. L. Rev. 153 (2002). Available at: <https://dsc.duq.edu/dlr/vol41/iss1/5>, which provides in pertinent part at pages 158 to 160 as follows;

- a) The prescribed method for challenging the computation of the results of an election is by filing a petition for recanvassing or recount with the court of common pleas. *Id.* §§ 3261, 3262. "Recanvassing" applies where votes are cast by machine; a "re- count" applies where votes are cast by paper ballot. *Id.*
- b) In order to request a recanvassing of an election district, a challenger must file a petition verified by affidavit from three voters from the district at issue. *In re* General Election of Luzerne County, 94 A.2d 565, 566 (Pa. 1953)
- c) The pleading threshold is low; the petitioners must aver only that "an error, although not apparent from the face of the returns, has been committed therein." 25 PA. CONS. STAT. § 3154(c)(1).
- d) If the recanvassing reveals fraud or substantial error, the court is required to grant the petitioners an additional five days to request that more machines be recanvassed. § 3263(a)(1).
- e) Further, if the court finds fraud or error, the court "shall correct, compute and certify to the county board the votes justly" §3263(a)(2).
- f) Sections 3261 and 3262 discourage unsubstantiated petitions by requiring that challengers post a bond of \$100.00 (or pay \$50 cash) per voting district to be recanvassed. If the recanvassing or recount fails to uncover evidence of fraud or substantial error, the challengers forfeit the fees.
- g) Thus, under the *In re Recanvassing of Certain Voting Machines*, 475 A.2d 1325, 1327 (Pa. 1984) decision, a petition for re- canvassing may be filed at any time until twenty days following an election, or five days after certification by the county board of elections, whichever time period is longer.

26. Simultaneously with the filing of this Petition, Petitioner deposited \$50.00 with the Delaware County Office of Judicial Support for each of the Petitioners' nine precincts as set forth in Paragraph 2 of this Petition, totaling \$450.00.

27. Delaware County Board of Elections has advertised that they will certify the election results on Monday, November 23, 2020, twenty days after the November 3, 2020, election. Consequently, this Petition(s) for Recount and Recanvassing is timely filed.

28. The Petitioners file these Petitions for the reasons set forth herein as well as due to their inability to obtain information addressing their concerns as to the canvassing and tabulation of votes from the General Election from any other source.

29. In Delaware County under both the Pennsylvania Election Code and the Delaware County Home Rule Charter (and Administrative Code), two independent boards are involved in the administration of elections, the Delaware County Board of Elections, and the Delaware County Voter Registration Commission.

30. Administratively, the Board of Elections supervises the administrative arm, the Bureau of Elections, as well as the voting machine warehouse operations while the Voter Registration Commission conducts its operations through the Voter Registration Department. These three (3) departments are involved in various capacities in the official computation of votes and ballots cast in the November 3, 2020 election. Petitioners are without knowledge as to other individuals involved in the official computation and also without knowledge as to each department's specific responsibilities and involvement.

31. Based upon information and belief, difficulties in the computation process have occurred in the official computation process. By way of example and not limitation, attached is a copy of an email from Christina Iacono, Delaware County Poll Worker

Coordinator, sent to presumably all Delco Poll Workers on November 12, 2020, at 11:01:39 PM, the subject line of which is “URGENT – Delaware County Bureau of Elections – Missing Precinct Data – ACTION REQUIRED FROM Minority Inspectors”. The email lists five areas of missing data. A true and correct copy of that email is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked Exhibit “G”.

32. The Return Board created a document, attached hereto and marked as Exhibit “D”, listing each of the 428 precincts in Delaware County, noting that ballots could not be reconciled in 78 precincts; and in an additional 17 precincts, no one returned the necessary documents to the Board, resulting in 95 precincts that were not reconciled.

33. Petitioners’ counsel has also been unable to obtain information as to the official computation and other issues involving the conduct of the election and the computation of the votes. By way of example, see the attached email to William Martin and J. Manly Parks asking about the recent process and procedure to be used which email remains unanswered. A true and correct copy of that email is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked Exhibit “H”.

34. By way of further example and not of limitation, Petitioner’s counsel has previously been unable to obtain responses from the Delaware County Government Election apparatus without threatening lawsuits or actually filing lawsuits. As an example, on September 28, 2020, Petitioner filed *Michael V. Puppio, Jr. v. Delaware County Board of Elections, and its Administrative Arm, Delaware County Bureau of Elections*, Delaware County Court of Common Pleas Docket No. CV-2020-006413. Only as a result of the filing and a Court proceeding, an Order was entered which is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked Exhibit “I”.

35. By way of further example and not of limitation, Petitioner's counsel attempted to consistently but was unable to obtain responses from the Delaware County Government Election apparatus without threatening lawsuits or actually filing lawsuits. As an example, on November 4, 2020, Petitioner filed *Delaware County Republican Executive Committee v. Delaware County Board of Elections*, Delaware County Court of Common Pleas Docket No. CV-2020-007523. Only as a result of the filing and a Court proceeding, an Order was entered which is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked Exhibit "J".

WHEREFORE, Petitioners respectfully request that this Honorable Court grant the Petition in the form of the Order submitted herewith, and order the Elections Board to make visible the registering counters, i.e., "v sticks" of the voting machine(s)/scanner(s) used to calculate the votes/ballots for the respective precincts, both walk-in and mail-in; open the ballot box(es) to cause the entire vote to be correctly counted by persons to be designated by the Court, (the ballot box(es) shall include all election day walk-in ballots together with all mail-in and absentee ballots and provisional ballots received by the County of Delaware for such district(s) including all machine/scanner tabulations/receipts, i.e., "v sticks" for all ballots, together with official sign-in poll "blue" books, "yellow" minority poll books, and all provisional over-seas, and military ballots); and order the Board of Elections not to certify the election returns until further Order of this Court.

§ 3261. Opening ballot boxes upon petition of electors alleging fraud or error; deposit or bond

(a) Except as set forth in subsection (a.1), the court of common pleas, or a judge thereof, of the county in which any election district is located in which ballots were used, shall open the ballot box of such election district used at any general, municipal, special or primary election held therein, and cause the entire vote thereof to be correctly counted by persons designated by such court or judge, if three qualified electors of the election district shall file, as hereinafter provided, a petition duly verified by them, alleging that upon information which they consider reliable they believe that fraud or error, although not manifest on the general return of votes made therefrom, was committed in the computation of the votes cast for all offices or for any particular office or offices in such election district, or in the marking of the ballots, or otherwise in connection with such ballots. It shall not be necessary for the petitioners to specify in their petition the particular act of fraud or error which they believe to have been committed, nor to offer evidence to substantiate the allegations of their petition.

(a.1) In cases resulting from a recount or recanvass order by the Secretary of the Commonwealth under section 1404(g), all of the following apply:

(1) Upon petition under clause (2), Commonwealth Court shall:

(i) open the ballot box of each election district in which ballots were used at a general, municipal, special or primary election; and

(ii) cause the entire vote of the election district to be correctly counted by persons designated by the court.

(2) To obtain relief under clause (1):

(i) Three (3) qualified electors of a county must file a verified petition alleging that, upon information which they consider reliable, they believe that fraud or error, although not manifest on the general return of votes, was committed:

(A) in the computation of votes cast;

(B) in the marking of the ballots; or

(C) otherwise in connection with the ballots.

(ii) It is not necessary for the petitioners to specify in their petition the particular act of fraud or error which they believe to have been committed nor to offer evidence to substantiate the allegations of their petition.

(b) Every petition for the opening of a ballot box under the provisions of this section shall be filed in the office of the prothonotary of the proper county, accompanied by a deposit of cash in the amount of fifty (\$ 50.00) dollars, or by a bond signed by the petitioners as principals and by a corporate surety to be approved by the court, in the amount of one hundred (\$ 100.00) dollars, conditioned upon the payment to the county treasurer for the use of the county of the sum of fifty (\$ 50.00) dollars, in the event that, upon the opening of the ballot box, it shall not appear that fraud or substantial error was committed in the computation of the votes cast on the ballots contained therein, or fraud in the marking of the ballots contained therein, or otherwise in connection with such ballots.

(c) Before any ballot box is opened under the provisions of this section, the court shall direct that notice of time and place of proposed recount be given, either personally or by registered mail, to each candidate for the office or offices which are to be recounted by the order of the court, and each such candidate may be present at such recount, either in person or by his attorney or by his duly authorized representative, under such regulations as the court may prescribe.

(d) If, upon opening any such ballot box, it shall appear that fraud or substantial error was committed in the computation of the votes cast on the ballots contained therein, or fraud in the marking of the ballots contained therein, or otherwise in connection with such ballots, it shall be the duty of the court to certify such fact to the prothonotary and thereupon the prothonotary shall return to the petitioners the said sum of fifty (\$ 50.00) dollars, or if the petitioners shall have filed a bond in lieu of cash, to mark said bond cancelled and notify the petitioners that he has done so.

(e) If, upon opening any ballot box under the provisions of this section, it shall not appear that fraud or substantial error was committed in the computation of the votes cast on the ballots contained therein, or fraud in the marking of the ballots contained therein, or otherwise in connection with such ballots, the persons upon whose petition such ballot box shall have been opened, shall forfeit to the county the sum of fifty (\$ 50.00) dollars. If said petitioners shall have deposited the said sum in cash with the prothonotary at the time of filing the petition, the prothonotary, upon certification of the court that fraud or substantial error was not discovered, shall pay said sum deposited with him to the county treasurer; and if the petitioners shall have filed with their petition a bond in the sum of one hundred (\$ 100.00) dollars, it shall be the duty of the county treasurer forthwith to collect from the principals or surety on said bond, the sum of fifty (\$ 50.00) dollars, and costs of suit, and for this purpose, he is hereby authorized to institute any necessary legal proceedings. When so collected, the said sum of fifty (\$ 50.00) dollars shall be paid over to the county treasurer.

(f) Ballot boxes may be opened under the provisions of this section at any time within four months after the date of the general, municipal, special or primary election at which the ballots therein shall have been cast.

§ 3262. Recanvassing voting machines upon petition of electors alleging fraud or error

(a) Judicial proceedings shall be as follows:

(1) Except as set forth in clause (2), the court of common pleas, or a judge thereof, of the county in which any election district is located, shall make visible the registering counters of the voting machine or machines used in such election district at any primary or election, and without unlocking the machine against voting, shall recanvass the vote cast therein, if three qualified electors of the election district shall file a petition, duly verified by them, alleging that, upon information which they consider reliable, they believe that fraud or error, although not manifest on the general return of votes made therefrom, was committed in the canvassing of the votes cast on such machine or machines. It shall not be necessary for the petitioners to specify in their petition the particular act of fraud or error they believe to have been committed, nor to offer evidence to substantiate the allegations of their petition.

(2) In cases resulting from a recount or recanvass ordered by the Secretary of the Commonwealth under section 1404(g), all of the following apply:

(i) Upon petition under subclause (ii), Commonwealth Court shall:

(A) make visible the registering counter of the voting machine used;

(B) without unlocking the machine against voting, recanvass the vote cast in the machine.

(ii) To obtain relief under subclause (i):

(A) Three qualified electors of the county must file a verified petition alleging that, upon information which they consider reliable, they believe that fraud or error, although not manifest on the general return of votes, was committed in the canvassing of the votes cast on the machine.

(B) It is not necessary for the petitioners to specify in their petition the particular act of fraud or error they believe to have been committed nor to offer evidence to substantiate the allegations of the petition.

(a.1) Every petition for the recanvassing of votes cast in the voting machine, or voting machines of an election district, under the provisions of this section, shall be filed in the office of the prothonotary of the proper county accompanied by a deposit of cash in the amount of fifty (\$ 50) dollars, or by a bond

signed by the petitioners as principals and by a corporate surety to be approved by the court in the amount of one hundred (\$ 100) dollars, conditioned upon the payment to the county treasurer for the use of the county of the sum of fifty (\$ 50) dollars, in the event that upon the recanvassing of the votes cast in a voting machine or voting machines, it does not appear that fraud or substantial error was committed in the canvassing of the votes cast on such machine or otherwise in connection with such voting machines.

(b.1) If, upon the recanvassing of the votes in any voting machine, it shall appear that fraud or substantial error was committed in the computation of the votes cast on the voting machine or otherwise in connection with such voting machine, it shall be the duty of the court to certify such fact to the prothonotary, and thereupon the prothonotary shall return to the petitioners the said sum of fifty (\$ 50) dollars, or if the petitioners shall have filed a bond, in lieu of cash, to mark said bond cancelled and notify the petitioners that he has done so.

(b.2) If, upon the recanvassing of the votes in any voting machine under the provisions of this section, it shall not appear that fraud or substantial error was committed in the computation of the votes cast in the voting machine or otherwise in connection with such voting machine, the persons upon whose petition such voting machine was recanvassed shall forfeit to the county the sum of fifty (\$ 50) dollars. If said petitioners shall have deposited the said sum in cash with the prothonotary at the time of filing the petition, the prothonotary, upon certification of the court that fraud or substantial error or otherwise in connection with such machine was not discovered, shall pay said sum deposited with him to the county treasurer, and if the petitioners shall have filed with their petition a bond in the sum of one hundred (\$ 100) dollars, it shall be the duty of the county treasurer forthwith to collect from the principals or surety on said bond the sum of fifty (\$ 50) dollars and costs of suit, and for this purpose he is hereby authorized to institute any necessary legal proceedings. When so collected, the said sum of fifty (\$ 50) dollars shall be paid over to the county treasurer.

(c) Voting machines may be recanvassed under the provisions of this section at any time within twenty days after the date of the primary or election at which they were used.

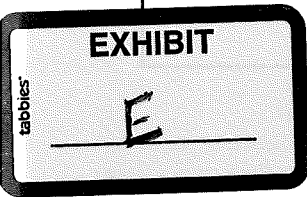

Thank you very much for your service on election day. We know that it was a long day and that things may have been missed during the closing procedures at the end of the night.

Unfortunately, due to missing data, election results from your precinct cannot be confirmed and approved for final tabulation until the missing data is reconciled.

In order to ensure that all votes cast will be counted, we need at least one member of your election team to come to the Machine Warehouse asap to help complete forms. If you were the minority inspector and were provided an envelope at the close of polls, Please bring the envelope with you to ensure the county has as much data as possible to correct issues in the precinct.

The missing data may be any of the following:

- Missing yellow numbered list of voters
- Incorrect numbers in the yellow book (numbers that do not match the scanner tabulation)
- Missing ballot reconciliation forms (this impacts the ballot chain of custody)
- Missing information on the close of night Return Sheet
- Missing Return Sheet

The machine warehouse is located at 403 East 24th Street in Chester PA and will be open Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday from 8:30AM-3PM.

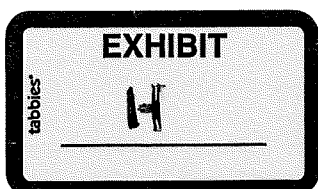

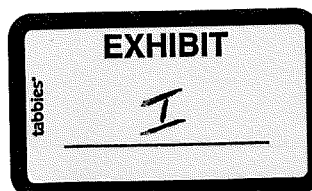

STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES

In response to Petitioner's Emergency Motion for Peremptory Judgment and Respondents Answer thereto, Petitioner and Respondents have agreed to the following:

It is hereby STIPULATED and AGREED by, between and among, Michael V. Puppio, Jr. ("Petitioner") and The Delaware County Board of Elections, and its Administrative Arm, The Delaware County Bureau of Elections ("Respondents"), through their undersigned Counsel, (collectively "the Parties") as follows:

1. Petitioner will receive a report containing the information set forth in 25 P.S. §3146.9 and 25 P.S. §3150.17 as described below, in digital format ("Absentee and Mail-In Ballot Report") via email. The digital format will be in a format which enables Petitioner to digitally sort, extract, and/or categorize the data contained in the report.

2. The Absentee and Mail-In Ballot Report will contain the items listed in Paragraph 2, subsection a, d, and e of 25 P.S. §3146.9 and 25 P.S. §3150.17 as follows:

- a. The elector's names and voter registration address extracted from the SURE system.
- d. The date on which the county board mails or delivers the absentee ballot to

the elector - date extracted from the SURE system.

- e. The date on which the elector's completed absentee ballot is received by the county board - date extracted from the SURE system.

3. The SURE system does not provide the information set forth in 25 P.S. § 3146.9(2)(b), (c) or 25 P.S. § 3150.17(2)(b), (c), therefore the report produced pursuant to this Stipulation cannot contain that information.

4. Respondents will make available to Petitioner in digital form, timely information regarding the rejections of online absentee or mail-in ballot applications and/or ballots, from the SURE system and use Respondents' best efforts to provide Petitioner a report on the applications and/or ballots that were received manually and then rejected by the Bureau of Elections.

5. Respondents will use their best efforts to provide Petitioner the Absentee and Mail-In Ballot Report and the information set forth in paragraphs 2 and 4 of this Stipulation on a daily basis, but in any event no less than twice per week, on Tuesdays and Thursdays to be transmitted to Petitioner via email.

6. When any delays or back logs occur at any steps in the processing of absentee and mail-in ballots, that delay or back log information will be provided to Petitioner as Respondents' good faith estimation of the delay and/or back log as part of the scheduled delivery of the Absentee and Mail-In Ballot Report to Petitioner.

7. The Court will retain jurisdiction.


AND NOW, to wit, this 4th day of November 2020, upon consideration of Petitioner's Emergency Petition or Relief Seeking Order Granting Access to Canvassing of Official Absentee Ballots and Mail-In Ballots, and the hearing held on November 4, 2020 wherein argument was heard from both Parties, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED as follows:

1. Four Observers in total (2 observers from the Republican Party, or affiliated candidates, and 2 observers from the Democratic Party, or affiliated candidates,) are permitted to observe the resolution area at all hours while ballots are being resolved;
2. Two observers (1 representing the Republican Party, or affiliated candidates, and 1 representing the Democratic Party, or affiliated candidates,) are permitted to observe the sorting machine area at all times while the machine is in use. However, all observers shall stand back while the machine is in use due to safety concerns.
3. At two-hour intervals, two observers in total (1 representing the Republican Party, or affiliated candidates, and 1 representing the Democratic party, or affiliated candidates) are permitted to enter the ballot room, to examine the room; however, are not permitted to examine the physical ballots contained within the room, individually. They must be escorted by a member of the Election Board Staff with the time not to exceed five minutes each visit.
