SUPPLEMENTAL EMERGENCY
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

BALDWIN, P.J.

AND NOW, this 3rd day of June, 2021, with the number of county residents who have been vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus increasing and the number of new virus cases in the County decreasing, it is the determination of the Court that it is appropriate to begin relaxing restrictions on judicial and administrative county functions which were necessitated for the health and safety of those who work in and visit the Schuylkill County Courthouse, Magisterial District Courts, and other County facilities. Accordingly, the Supplemental Emergency Order dated May 27, 2021 is amended as follows:

- (1) Masks – Beginning June 7, 2021, at 8:00 a.m., those county and judicial employees and members of the public who have been fully vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus will no longer be required to wear masks inside the Courthouse, Magisterial District Courts, and other County Facilities. Masks will still be required for those individuals who have not been vaccinated, and all

individuals entering said locations will be required to submit to a non-invasive monitoring of their temperature as they enter. The Sheriff and his deputies will continue to be authorized and directed to deny entrance to anyone who has an elevated temperature or is visibly ill.

- (2) Public Access – Until June 14, 2021, access to Court and County facilities by the public and litigants shall continue to be restricted pursuant to the previous Supplemental Emergency Orders dated December 30, 2020 and April 23, 2021. Beginning at 8:30 a.m. on June 14, 2021, litigants and members of the public may be granted access to the Courthouse, Magisterial District Courts and County Offices without the necessity of an advance appointment to file or examine documents, apply for licenses, or to conduct other county business.
- (3) Canteen Services – Beginning at 8:30 a.m. on June 14, 2021, the tables and chairs in the area adjacent to the Courthouse Canteen may be used by canteen customers only for the eating of meals and snacks.
