

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

AND NOW, this 6th day of July, 2021, pursuant to the order of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court of July 1, 2021, permitting this court to suspend state and local rules that restrict the use of advanced communication technology (ACT) in court proceedings, as well as any rule that prevents electronic filings of cases in this Judicial District, it is hereby **ORDERED, DIRECTED AND DECREED** that the judicial emergency is extended for these purposes until August 31, 2021 and such rules are suspended. Judges and MDJs shall be present in the courthouse or court facility whenever a proceeding is being conducted by ACT.
