COMMITTEE ANSWER TO APPLICATIONS FOR SUMMARY RELIEF AND CROSS-APPLICATION FOR SUMMARY RELIEF

Per Pa.R.A.P. 123 and 1532(b), for the reasons set forth below and in the accompanying brief, which is incorporated here by reference, Respondents Senator Cris Dush, Senator Jake Corman, and the Pennsylvania State Senate Intergovernmental Operations Committee (collectively, the "Committee") hereby answer the pending applications for summary relief, asking that they be denied, and also cross-move for summary relief in their favor; in support of these requests, the Committee avers as follows:

- 1. Presently pending before the Court by the parties to the consolidated cases are three separate applications for summary relief.
- 2. Separately pending before the Court is a proposed application for summary relief filed by various proposed intervenors.
- 3. An application for summary relief can only be granted "if a party's right to judgment is clear and no material issues of fact are in dispute." *Hosp. & Healthsystem Ass'n of Pa. v. Com.*, 77 A.3d 587, 602 (Pa. 2013) (quotations removed).
- 4. As set forth fully in the accompanying brief, the movants' rights to judgment are not clear because: (1) some of the movants lack standing; (2) the claims are not ripe at least in part; and (3) the claims

fail on their merits as a matter of law.

- 5. Separately, to the extent the Court's analysis depends on the "evidence" attached to the applications, that evidence is disputed, and thus the applications must be denied on that separate ground.
- 6. Conversely, the Committee is entitled to summary relief because the Pennsylvania Constitution affirmatively permits the Committee to engage in a legislative investigation into election matters though the Subpoena, and none of the purportedly substantive challenges to the Subpoena have merit.
- 7. Separately, the Committee has an independent statutory right to the information sought with the Subpoena.

WHEREFORE, the Committee respectfully requests that the Court deny the pending applications for summary relief and grant this cross-application, and enter an order compelling the Acting Secretary to respond to the Subpoena within 14 days.
