- 9. Perhaps it would be better just to wait until the U.S. Supreme Court acts on the Petition for Certiorari.

WHEREFORE, Mr. Stretton respectfully requests that he be allowed to withdraw as counsel since Mr. Lowry is not in a position to pay legal fees and apparently wants to go his own way in this case.
