**GRESSMAN PETITIONERS' REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION**

Petitioners in Case No. 142 MM 2021, Philip T. Gressman, Ron Y. Donagi, Kristopher R. Tapp, Pamela Gorkin, David P. Marsh, James L. Rosenberger, Amy Myers, Eugene Boman, Gary Gordon, Liz McMahon, Timothy G. Feeman, and Garth Isaak (collectively, the “Gressman Petitioners”) respectfully request that this Court clarify that its January 31, 2022 Order staying the proceedings of the Commonwealth Court in this Court’s Case No. 7 MM 2022 extends to the Commonwealth Court’s proceedings in its Case No. 465 MD 2021. The Gressman Petitioners seek this clarification to ensure that the petitioners in the two cases before the Commonwealth Court that implicate congressional redistricting—Case Nos. 464 MD 2021 and 465 MD 2021, which have been consolidated in the Commonwealth Court—are treated alike in all procedural respects in this Court. To provide greater clarity to the parties and the public going forward, the Court also may wish to consolidate the three related proceedings that have been filed in this Court, Case Nos. 141 MM 2021, 142 MM 2021, and 7 MM 2022.
