I am pleased to enclose our decennial Magisterial District Realignment Plan for the 16th Judicial District. Included is our Judicial District Summary Worksheet, our 5 Magisterial District Summary Worksheets and a map showing the proposed realignment and major roadways in Somerset County.

Statistics compiled by the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts show that in terms of average annual court filings, Somerset County is the sixth busiest of the 24 sixth-class counties in Pennsylvania. Somerset County magisterial district courts average 3,789 case filings per year. By comparison, magisterial district courts in the other sixth-class counties average just 3,230 filings per year. The upshot of these statistics is that Somerset County magisterial district courts are quite busy in comparison to similarly situated magisterial district courts across Pennsylvania. Consequently, our focus was not to eliminate offices but to reallocate the caseloads to achieve a more even distribution among the five offices.

District Court 16-3-03 is the most problematic. This office alone had over 29,000 traffic cases over the statistical reporting period, greatly skewing its workload totals in comparison to the other offices in the district. Our challenge was to devise a way to break these traffic cases up in order to more evenly balance workloads among the offices. As you will see in our plan, we have proposed shifting Somerset Township's heavy Turnpike traffic caseload to District Court 16-3-05 to achieve this goal. We believe this is the most appropriate way to achieve an even distribution of workloads for the 16th Judicial District.

We propose to implement most of our changes on January 3, 2023. The exception is Lincoln Township, which is the home municipality of the magisterial district judge in District 16-3-03. That judge plans to retire at the end of his current term in 2023, which will allow us to shift Lincoln Township to District 16-3-01 on January 2, 2024. Once we finalize realignment, we anticipate that all offices will fall within the 15% target set by the Supreme Court.

Our Magisterial District Realignment Plan was released for public inspection and comment on November 24, 2021. All comments we received are attached to the Magisterial District Summary Worksheet for the district court to which the comment pertains.

MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT REALIGNMENT PLAN

I am pleased to release the court's decennial Magisterial District Realignment Plan for the 16th Judicial District. Included in the release are a Judicial District Summary Worksheet, Magisterial District Worksheets for all five magisterial districts, and a map depicting the proposed realignments and major roadways in Somerset County.

Statistics compiled by the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts show that in terms of average annual court filings, Somerset County is the sixth busiest of the 24 sixth-class counties in Pennsylvania.¹ Somerset County magisterial district courts average 3,789 case filings per year. By comparison, magisterial district courts in the other sixth-class counties average just 3,230 filings per year. The upshot of these statistics is that Somerset County magisterial district courts are quite busy in comparison to similarly situated magisterial district courts across Pennsylvania.

In Somerset County—and indeed across much of Pennsylvania—the magisterial districts are not aligned in a way that allows for equal or near equal distribution of caseloads among the several magisterial courts in the county. This problem is most clearly illustrated by the difference in caseloads between Somerset County's busiest magisterial court (average annual caseload of 8,596), and its two least busy courts (average annual caseloads of 1,696 and 1,576). This caseload disparity causes wide-ranging case management challenges for the high caseload courts, while unduly casting the low caseload courts in a less-than-favorable light in the media and elsewhere. I recognize our magisterial district courts with lower caseloads did not choose their caseloads; the caseloads were imposed on them by the past alignment decisions of higher courts.

For the 2021-2022 decennial realignment, the Pennsylvania Supreme Court has instructed president judges to draw district boundaries so that workload is equitably distributed among the magisterial district courts in the county. No magisterial district court is to have a total workload that is 15% less or greater than any other magisterial district court in the county.

I believe this Magisterial District Realignment Plan complies with the Supreme Court's guidance. As you review the court's plan, you will see that we have realigned several boroughs and townships. The most challenging aspect of devising the plan involved allocating the heavy traffic caseloads generated by the Pennsylvania Turnpike. I acknowledge that some aspects of this plan don't make perfect sense from a geographic or convenience standpoint, particularly from the perspective of certain constituencies who regularly use the courts. But those flaws having been acknowledged, I believe they are secondary to the Supreme Court's instruction to achieve equitable caseload distribution.
