ORDER


On March 6, 2023, Joseph Green, Esquire (Candidate) filed with the Department of State, a Nomination Petition as a candidate for the Judge of Court of Common Pleas, First Judicial District of Pennsylvania.

On March 14, 2023, Joseph McAteer (Objector) filed a Petition to Set Aside Nomination Petition (Objections) of Candidate, for, *inter alia*, failure to present 1000 signatures, which is required to be placed on the primary election ballot. Section 912.1 of the Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2872.1.

After a Hearing on March 30, 2023, but before a decision was rendered by the Court, Objector withdrew his petition said Hearing was ADJORNED.

Accordingly, Candidate shall remain on the primary election ballot for the position of Judge of the Court of Common Pleas.

The Prothonotary is directed to mark this matter CLOSED.
