PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS PETITION FOR IMPOSITION OF BAIL

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Relator/Defendant, LUIGI-MANGIONE, by and through his attorney, Thomas M. Dickey, Esquire, respectfully represents as follows:

1. Relator/Defendant, LUIGI MANGIONE, is presently incarcerated in the State Correctional Institution Huntingdon, located in Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania.

- 2. Respondent is the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and John Rivello, Superintendent, State Correctional Institution of Huntingdon, Pennsylvania
- 3. Relator/Defendant was arrested on 12/09/2024 in Blair County, Pennsylvania and charged with various offenses at incident number 2024-29133.
- 4. Relator/Defendant is also the subject of a police criminal complaint filed on 12/10/2024 in Blair County Pennsylvania at 2024 M.D. 1546. Said complaint has been filed pursuant to the Uniform Criminal Extradition Act; 42 Pa C.S.A. § 9121 et. seq.
- 5. Said complaint has been filed upon receipt of a Warrant of Arrest filed in the Criminal Court, City of New York at CR-036031-24NY. Said Warrant of Arrest alleges and charges that Relator/Defendant committed the offense of PL 125.25(i).
- 6. Relator/Defendant alleges that his incarceration in the State Correctional Institution Huntingdon is illegal and unlawful in that the Commonwealth has not proven that:
 - a. Relator/Defendant was present in the demanding state (New York) at the time of the commission of the Offense Charged as required by the Uniform Criminal Extradition Act; and/or,
 - b. that sufficient probable cause exists establishing that
 Relator/Defendant committed the Offense Charged in the demanding
 state (New York) and/or,
 - c. that Relator/Defendant is a fugitive from the demanding state (New York)
 - 7. All of the foregoing requirements must be met under the Uniform Criminal Extradition Act; 42 Pa C.S.A. § 9121 et. seq. Insofar that the requirements of said Act have not been met at the present time. The Relator/Defendant must be released and discharged from custody, and all proceedings instituted by the Commonwealth relative to extradition must be dismissed with prejudice.

- 8. Insofar as no evidence has been presented that the Offense Charged under the Warrant of Arrest filed in the Criminal Court, City of New York at CR-036031-24NY is punishable by death or life imprisonment under the laws of the state in which it was alleged to of been committed, Relator/Defendant is entitled to Bail under the Uniform Criminal Extradition Act 42 Pa C.S.A. § 9137.
- 9. Relator/Defendant reserves the right to file an amended and/or supplemental petition upon receipt of additional information and/or Governor's Warrant.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner, Relator/Defendant respectfully praise and requests that this Honorable Court enter an Order:

- (a) discharging him from custody and dismissing the extradition instituted by the Commonwealth with prejudice; and/or
- (b) admitting him to bail by bond with sufficient sureties and in such sum deemed proper; and/or
- (c) permitting Petitioner leave to file an amended or supplemental petition and/or motion
- (d) granting any other relief deemed appropriate
