INTRODUCTION

Associate Justice Sandra Schultz Newman (1938-) has a number of important milestones in her illustrious career as the first female Assistant Attorney in Montgomery County, the fifth female judge elected to the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania in November 1993, and the first female elected to a full-term in the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania in November 1995, serving a full term from January 1996 to January 2006, winning a retention election in November 2005, and serving for another year before returning to private practice in 2007.

Newman's professional career showed a steady rise in positions before becoming a full-time jurist and she has succeeded in her post-judicial position as a prominent arbitrator/mediator. She holds four Honorary Doctorate degrees, numerous honors and awards, and has extensive activities and memberships in a variety of professional organizations. Newman has also contributed to legal periodical literature as well as participating in various appellate practice seminars published by the Pennsylvania Bar Institute/Pennsylvania Bar Association.

In Commonwealth Court, Judge Newman authored 103 opinions, including 88 majority opinions, 14 dissenting opinions, and one concurring and dissenting opinion. In the Supreme Court, Justice Newman authored 401 opinions, including 239 majority opinions, 53 concurring opinions, 91 dissenting opinions, and 18 concurring and dissenting opinions. The opinions listed here are all that she wrote and does not include those opinions that she joined in concurring, dissenting, or concurring and dissenting opinions. The list is drawn from Westlaw and Lexis databases.

The Justices of the Supreme Court have decided to honor Justice Newman with the naming of the Courtroom in a special ceremony on September 9, 2025.
