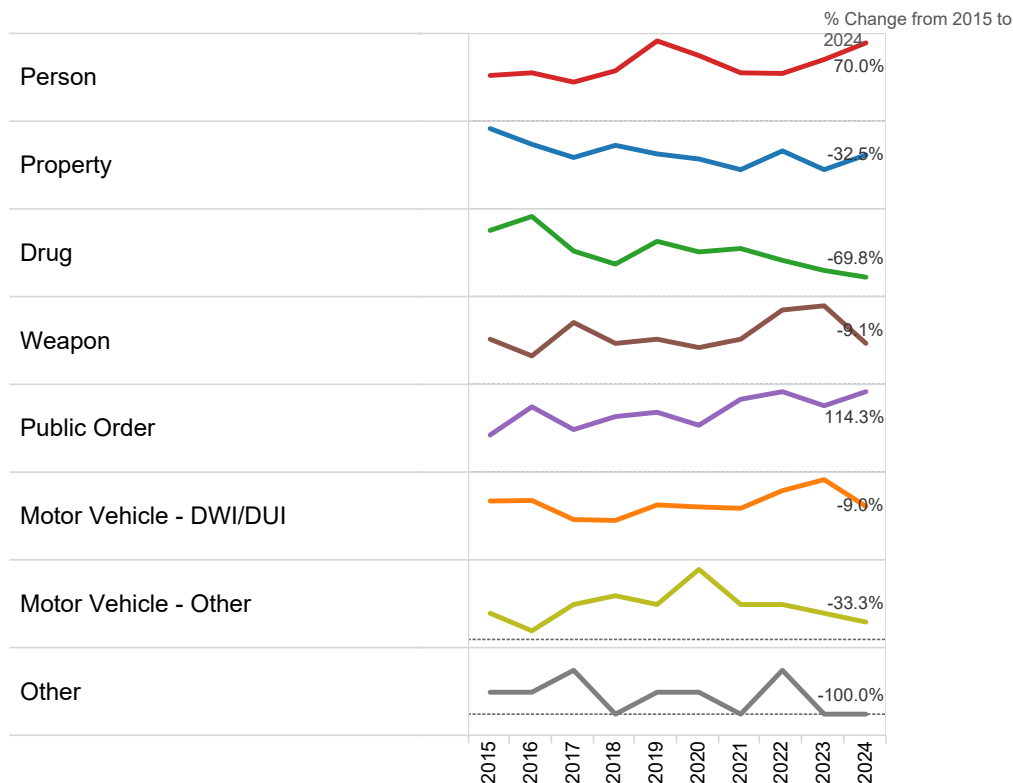

### Criminal New Cases by Offense Type, 2015-2024

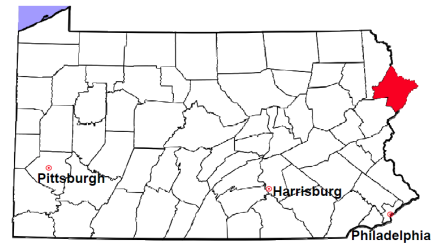

**ESTABLISHED:**

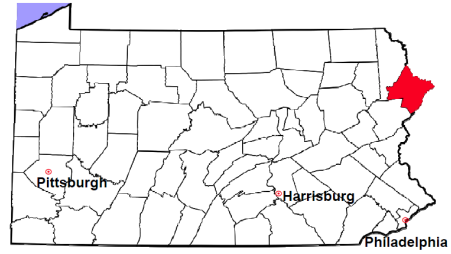

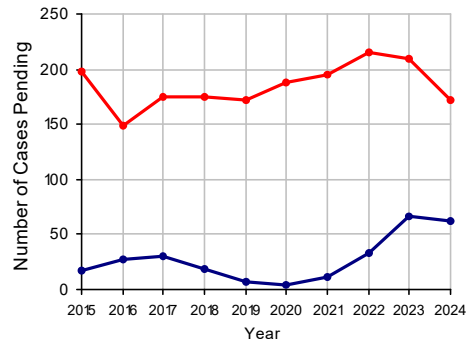


Clearance Rate, 2015-2024

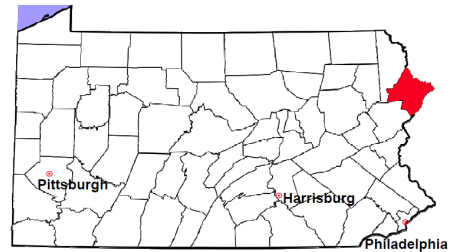

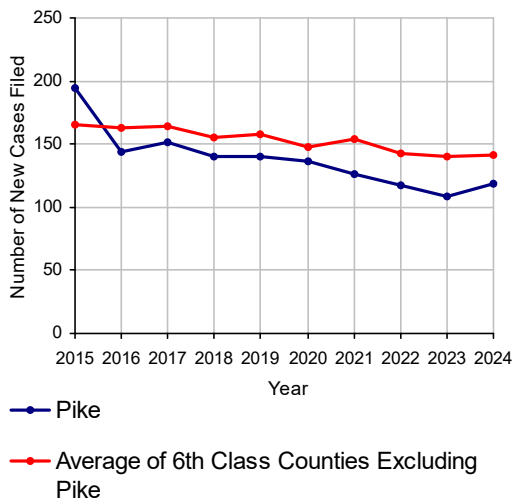

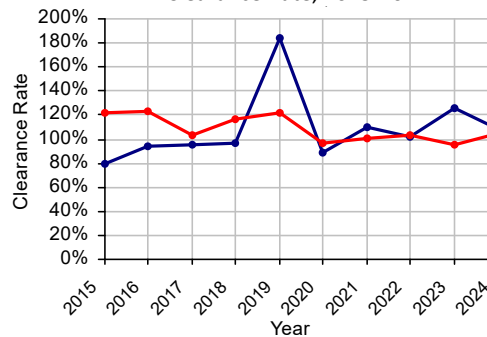

Divorce New Cases Filed, 2015-2024

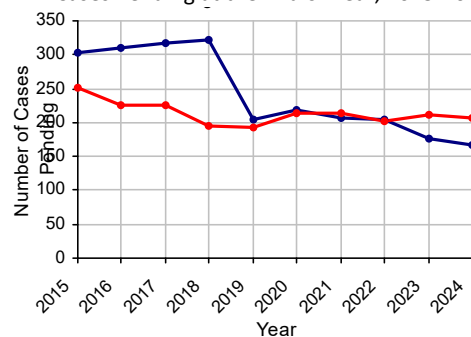


Clearance Rate, 2015-2024

### Delinquency New Cases by Offense Type, 2017-2024

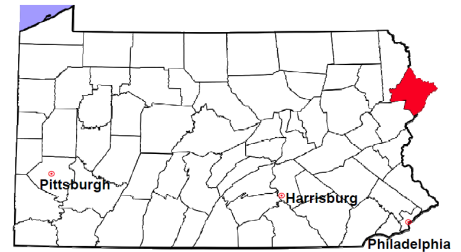
