

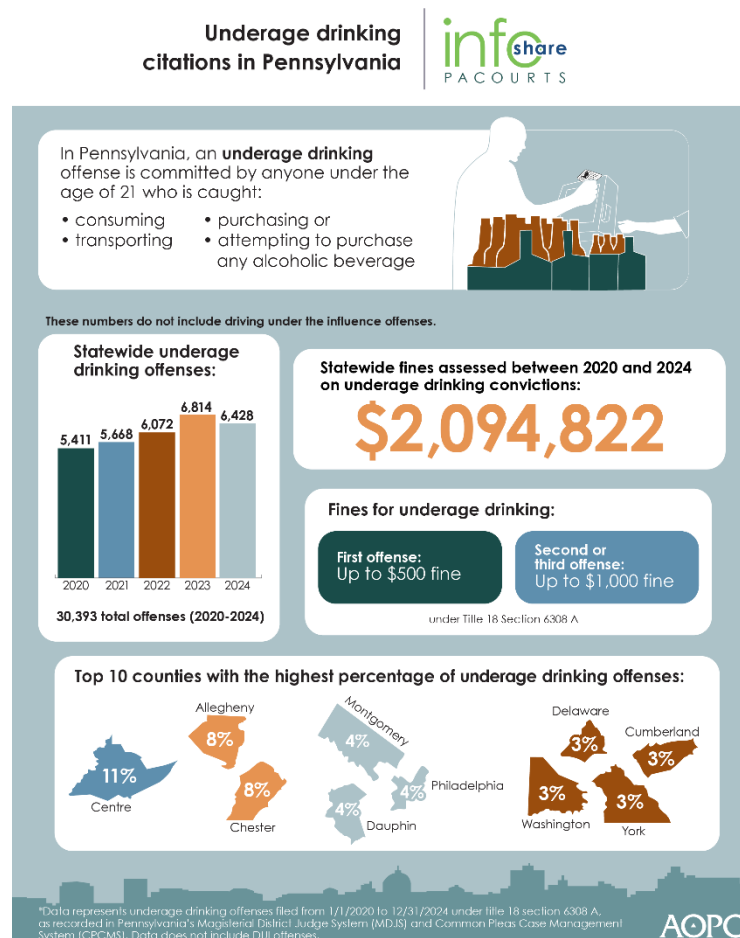

Underage drinking offenses in Pennsylvania

HARRISBURG — Over the past five years, underage drinking offenses statewide totaled 30,393. In Pennsylvania, an underage drinking offense is committed by anyone under the age of 21 who is caught possessing, consuming, transporting, purchasing or attempting to purchase any alcoholic beverage. These numbers *do not include driving under the influence offenses*.
