ORDER

AND NOW, this 25th day of March, 2026, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Based upon the credible evidence admitted at the March 25, 2026 hearing before this Court, William Parker (Objector) is a resident of Pennsylvania's 12th Congressional District; Objector therefore lacks standing to pursue this action. The Petition to Set Aside the Nomination Petition of Chris DeLuzio, Candidate for the Democratic Nomination for Representative in Congress in the 17th U.S. Congressional District of Pennsylvania, in the Primary Election to be held on May 19, 2026, filed by Objector is hereby **DENIED**.

2. The Secretary of the Commonwealth is directed to **PLACE** the name of Chris DeLuzio, as a Candidate for the Democratic Nomination to the office of Representative in Congress in the 17th U.S. Congressional District of Pennsylvania Primary Election of May 19, 2026.

3. Upon consideration of Objector's oral motion for costs at the March 25, 2026 hearing before this Court, said motion is **DENIED** without prejudice. Each party shall bear his, her, or their own costs.

4. The Prothonotary shall notify the parties hereto and their counsel of this order and shall also certify a copy hereof to the Secretary of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania forthwith.

5. An opinion in support of this order will follow.
