ORDER ENDING SUSPENSION

Respondent Judge Michael Fanning has filed a Petition to Vacate the Order of Interim Suspension Without Pay concerning this Court's Order of March 12, 2026, suspending Judge Fanning. Judge Fanning's Petition is based on the dismissal by the District Attorney of all charges against him. Judge Fanning points out that his suspension was based solely on that now dismissed criminal prosecution. Petition to Vacate, at Paragraph 3.

Judge Fanning correctly states that he was suspended without pay based solely on the existence of the charges against him and that the District Attorney has dismissed those charges. With no charges and no other reason cited for the suspension of Judge Fanning no reason exists for that suspension to continue.

The Response of the Judicial Conduct Board to Judge Fanning's Petition to Vacate his Suspension does not oppose this request. In fact, the Judicial Conduct Board admits in the Concluding Paragraph of

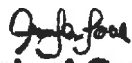
its Response "the Board is without a legal basis upon which to object to the requested relief."

With the sole basis for the suspension of Judge Fanning being the existence of charges against him and those charges having been dismissed, the Suspension Without Pay is hereby ended.
