ORDER

AND NOW, this 18th day of August, 2026, following a hearing on Objectors' Petition to Set Aside Nomination Petition, the Court finds as follows:

Candidate, Brian John Peltier, by and through his counsel of record, stipulated that he does not have the requisite valid signatures to be placed on the 2026 General Election Ballot as a Libertarian Party candidate for the office of Representative in the 60th Legislative District of Pennsylvania. Accordingly, Candidate, Brian John Peltier, through his counsel of record, sought leave to withdraw his nomination papers and requested that this Court enter an order removing his name from the ballot.

As such, it is hereby ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commonwealth is directed to remove the name of Brian John Peltier from the November 3, 2026 General Election Ballot, as a Libertarian Party candidate for the office of Representative in the 60th Legislative District of Pennsylvania.

The parties shall bear their own costs.
