ORDER

AND NOW, this 31st day of August 2026, upon consultation with the District Court Administrator, Centre County Sheriff, and the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, the following Order is entered:

The terms of this order apply to the conduct of Preliminary Hearings scheduled to begin at 8:30am on Wednesday, September 2, 2026, in Courtroom 1 at the Centre County Courthouse, Bellefonte, PA.

The provisions noted as "Mandatory" shall be applied by the Court and enforced accordingly by its officers. The provisions noted as "informational" are intended to provide meaningful structure and guidance to the working media and general public.

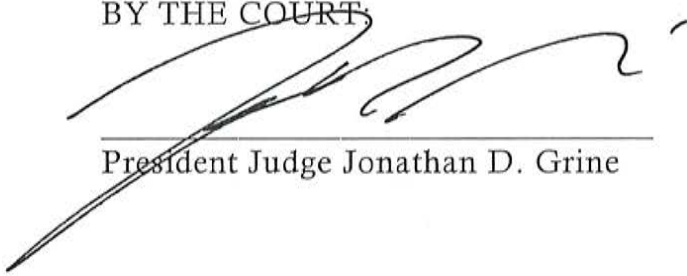
MANDATORY

1. The working media and general public will be admitted to the courtroom beginning at 7:45am. Admittance to the courtroom will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. No one will be admitted to the courtroom prior to 7:45am, except as authorized by the District Court Administrator and Centre County Sheriff. All working media and general public must be seated before the proceedings begin.
3. The working media will be permitted to use laptops, electronic tablets, or similar devices in the courtroom for the sole purpose of notetaking.
4. No electronic recording of pictures or voices during the proceedings is permitted.
5. The general public and working media are permitted to carry cell phones in the courthouse, but all such devices must be placed on SILENT throughout the proceedings.
6. Those seated in the courtroom are expected to remain in their seats until the court calls a recess and/or the proceeding(s) have concluded.
7. No news media interviews shall be conducted in Courtroom 1 or anywhere in the Courthouse (including corridors, hallways, elevator, interior or exterior steps, or the Courthouse parking lot).
8. The Sheriff of Centre County, in consultation with the Court, shall have authority to make such reasonable rules and regulations as may be required to provide adequate security intended to assure the safety of all those in the courthouse, and on the Courthouse grounds, and the orderly conduct of the proceedings. These regulations may include:
 - a. No member of the working media or general public will be permitted to take backpacks, large purses or satchels of any kind into the Courtroom, except authorized by the Sheriff.
 - b. Food or beverages will not be permitted in the Courthouse.
 - c. No person except those immediately involved in the proceedings will be permitted beyond the bar of Courtroom at any time.

INFORMATIONAL

- No satellite courtroom or press room will be available.
- The working media and general public are reminded that Pennsylvania law and Bellefonte Borough ordinances prohibit parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant; or parking in a manner that prevents an emergency vehicle from travelling on borough streets. Damage caused to borough or county property will be reported immediately to a law enforcement officer and a police report will be filed.
- No municipal streets and/or employee parking lots will be closed to accommodate satellite trucks.
- Parking is very limited around the Courthouse and within Bellefonte Borough. Those attending the proceedings should allow sufficient time to find parking.
- Anyone removed from the courtroom by the Sheriff and/or law enforcement official will not be permitted to reenter the courtroom.
