Pennsylvania Supreme Court to Hold Oral Argument Session in Philadelphia

HARRISBURG- The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania will hold oral argument sessions on Tues., Sept. 15 and Wed., Sept. 16 in the Supreme Court courtroom in City Hall, beginning at 9:30 a.m. each day.
