## **MEMORANDUM AND ORDER**

AND NOW, this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2016, it appearing that the Application of PA Media Group, WITF, Inc. and Hearst Properties Inc., d/b/a WGAL-TV (collectively, PA Media Group) for Leave to Intervene is unopposed and that PA Media Group has averred a sufficient interest to intervene in the above-matter, the Application for Leave to Intervene is GRANTED.

PA Media Group's Cross-Application in the Nature of a Petition for Declaratory Relief and Response in Opposition to the Application for Declaratory Relief of Impact Harrisburg, which were filed simultaneously with its Application for Leave to Intervene, are accepted as filed and docketed.

Further, leave to intervene herein is limited to the interest set forth in PA Media Group's Application for Leave to Intervene, that is, to respond to and oppose Impact Harrisburg's Application for Relief, which seeks a declaratory judgment regarding whether it is an "agency" for purposes of the Sunshine Act, 65 Pa. C.S. §§ 701-716.

Finally, any answer to PA Media Group's Cross-Application in the Nature of a Petition for Declaratory Relief shall be filed on or before March 30, 2016.
