MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE AMENDED BOARD COMPLAINT

AND NOW, this 14th day of July, 2017, comes the Judicial Conduct Board, by and through Board counsel, and files this Motion for Leave to File Amended Board Complaint against the Honorable Michael G. Shaw, Magisterial District Judge for Magisterial District 43-3-02 of Bradford County, Pennsylvania for the reasons set forth herein:

The Court of Judicial Discipline Rules of Procedure permit the Board to 1. file an amendment to a Board Complaint pursuant to Rule 303(A) which provides in pertinent part:

> Amendments. Upon motion, the Court or the Conference Judge may permit amendments to a board Complaint with the written consent of the Judicial Officer. . . .

- On November 1, 2016, the Board filed a Board Complaint against 2. Magisterial District Judge Michael G. Shaw, which is pending before this Court.
- On November 4, 2016, the Board initiated a new Confidential Request for Investigation against Judge Shaw at JCB File No. 2016-643 and conducted a full investigation.

- 4. On December 6, 2016, Judge Shaw's former counsel, Rinaldo A. DePaola, Esquire, filed the Answer to the Board Complaint in the CJD.
- 5. The subject matter of the investigation at JCB File No. 2016-643 arises from and is related to the allegations set forth in the Board Complaint in *In re Shaw*, 5 JD 2016.
- 6. As a result of its investigation of JCB File No. 2016-643, and pursuant to Article V, § 18(a)(7) of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Board determined that there is probable cause to file formal charges against Judge Shaw.
- 7. The factual allegations arising from JCB File No. 2016-643 are set forth in the attached Amended Board Complaint, *In re Shaw*, 5 JD 2016, at Section D, Additional Facts Pursuant to JCB File No. 2016-643, Paragraph Nos. 215-257.
- 8. The alleged judicial misconduct arising from JCB File No. 2016-643 occurred after November 30, 2014 and therefore, the New Rules Governing Standards of Conduct of Magisterial District Judges (R.G.S.C.M.D.J.) apply to those allegations of misconduct.
- 9. The allegations of misconduct based on JCB File No. 2016-643 are set forth in the attached Amended Board Complaint at Section E, Charges at Count One, Paragraph Nos. 273-278; Count Two, Paragraph No. 292; Count Three, Paragraph No. 311; and Count Four, Paragraph Nos. 330-333. The conduct set forth in Section D is also included as a basis for alleged misconduct at Count Five, Article V, § 17(b) and Count Seven, the Disrepute Clause of § 18(d)(1).

10. Judge Shaw, by and through his counsel, William A. Hebe, Esquire, consents to the amendment of the Board Complaint as evidenced by the attached Consent to Amendment of Board Complaint bearing his signature.

WHEREFORE, the Board respectfully requests that this Honorable Court grant it leave to file the attached Amended Board Complaint.
