 The winner of the Special Election will serve for the remainder of the current 115th Congress; this lawsuit concerns the plan that will be in effect beginning with

the May 2018 primary and November 2018 election for the 116th Congress.

Proposed Intervenor Saccone does not articulate any reason other than the Special Election (which this litigation will not affect) as to why his interests are any different from or are not adequately represented by the existing Intervenors.

By way of further response, the relevant interests in a redistricting case are the interests of voters, not the interests of candidates. *See Erfer v. Commonwealth*, 794 A.2d 325, 330 (Pa. 2002); *Albert v. 2001 Legislative Reapportionment Comm'n*, 790 A.2d 989, 994-95 (Pa. 2002) ("[I]t is the right to vote and the right to have one's vote counted that is the subject matter of a reapportionment challenge.").

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Petitioners respectfully request that the Court deny the Application to Include Rick Saccone as an Intervenor.
