ORDER

PER CURIAM

AND NOW, this 15th day of January, 2026, the Petition for Allowance of Appeal is **GRANTED, LIMITED TO** the following issue, stated by Petitioner:

Did the sentencing court impose an illegal sentence by imposing separate, consecutive sentences for Swift's convictions for two counts of Arson-Endangering Property, where the statute providing for the offense, properly construed according to the rules of statutory interpretation, provided for a single sentence no matter how many properties were endangered?

The Superior Court's order is **VACATED**, and this matter is **REMANDED** for reconsideration in light of *Commonwealth v. Smith*, --- A.3d ---, 2025 WL 3229045 (Pa. filed Nov. 19, 2025). Allowance of appeal is **DENIED** as to all remaining issues.
