The application for relief filed by Appellants Roberta Winters, Nichita Sandur, Kathy Foster-Sandru, Robin Roberts, Kierstyn Zolfo, Michael Zolfo, Phyllis Hilley, Ben Bowens, the League of Women Voters of Pennsylvania, Common Cause Pennsylvania and Make the Road Pennsylvania (collectively "Voter-Intervenors") in the matter docketed at 28 MAP 2023, entitled Unopposed Application for Leave to "re-File" Voter-Intervenors' Reply Brief, is hereby DENIED, given that this Court has dismissed the underlying appeal.
