ORDER

PER CURIAM

AND NOW, this 6th day of March, 2026, the Application for Leave to File Original Process and the “Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus” are DISMISSED to the extent they seek redress as to any matter on which Petitioner is represented by counsel. See Pa.R.A.P. 102 (defining “hybrid representation” as “[a]n attempt to act as counsel for oneself when one has counsel of record”); see *also* Pa.R.A.P. 121(g) (generally prohibiting hybrid representation). The Prothonotary is DIRECTED to forward the submissions to counsel of record.

In all other respects, the Application for Leave to File Original Process is GRANTED to the extent it seeks leave to file original process and is DENIED to the extent it seeks any other relief, and the “Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus” is DENIED.
