AND NOW, this 13th day of February, 2026, the “Motion for Extension of Admission to Practice Law Pursuant to Pa.B.A.R. 311(g)” is DENIED. *See generally In the Matter of Hart, 2025 WL 1501819 (per curiam order filed May 27, 2025)* (extending a Rule 311 admittee’s admission through April 30, 2026); *see also id.* (Dougherty, J., concurring, joined by Donohue, Mundy, Brobson, and McCaffery, JJ.) (criticizing the Court’s prior “lax” approach to Rule 311 extension requests and emphasizing that, going forward, the Court intends to enforce the “good cause shown” requirement of Pa.B.A.R. 311(g); further signaling that limited extensions may be available for Rule 311 admittees to sit for and receive the results from the February 2026 Pennsylvania Bar Examination).
