See In re A.J.R.-H., 188 A.3d 1157, 1167-70 (Pa. 2018) (holding that documentary evidence was inadmissible under the business records exception to the hearsay rule, see Pa.R.E. 803(6), where an agency witness testified regarding the process of obtaining documents from third parties, but "[n]o witness stated that she was
